Salat - The Muslim Prayer Book - Al Islam

The first pillar of Islam is the Islamic declaration of faith, ie to bear witness that there is none worthy of worship except Allah, and that Muhammad is the Messenger of Allah The oneness of God is the basis of our belief in Islam The second pillar is called Salat, ie to perform Prayer in a prescribed form
